Did you know? You can get a COVID-19 Booster at Home!

CDR Health, an agency that partners with the state of Massachusetts, is offering free COVID-19 In-Home Vaccines! This is for anyone who has difficulty getting to or using a community vaccination location, <u>for any reason</u>. This program is available statewide, including the Islands. Ages 6 months and up. All vaccine types (Pfizer, Moderna, Novavax, and J&J) and boosters are available. You can sign up for an appointment by phone at (833) 983-0485, **or visit with Ella to do the online intake.**

Food Resource Updates

- As of October 31st, the SKIP gift card program has ended.
 - During the winter months we will have a small number of gift cards available on a monthly basis for people with a pressing need. These will be distributed by Ella, so you need to request with Ella.
- Other food resources:
 - talk to Ella about applying for SNAP benefits;
 - meet with Mary to get your \$65/monthly stipend switched to a Stop and Shop card;
 - sign-up for the monthly mobile food pantry delivery;
 - The Soup Kitchen in Provincetown (SKIP) serves hot, nutritious lunches
 12:30-1:30, M-F at the Methodist Church on Shankpainter
- We have been offered a partnership with Lower Cape Outreach's new food program: monthly delivery to HOW of "fresh" groceries for clients (including produce and protein, not frozen, purchased at Stop & Shop). Call Ella to do an intake for this additional grocery resource.

PTown's New Dental Clinic Accepts MassHealth!

Oral health is so important, but easy to neglect if you don't have dental insurance. Did you know that you can get your dental work done for free if you have Masshealth? (Co-pays may apply depending on your plan).

Get a Free \$75 Gift Card for Getting a COVID-19 Booster Sho

The Massachusetts Department of Public Health is partnering on over 200 free COVID-19 vaccination clinics that will offer an enhanced incentive for getting protected through the end of 2022.

A \$75 gift card for area retailers will be offered to any MA resident (all ages) who gets vaccinated (first dose, second dose, or booster) at the clinics listed on mass.gov/GetBoosted.

Do you get a monthly mobile pantry box?

After the recent monthly delivery in a downpour we are updating our mobile pantry delivery policy. If you receive monthly food drop-offs through our mobile pantry, you must be home on the last Wednesday of the month to accept your box. If you are not home, we will leave it at the door, but cannot guarantee that it won't become soggy or damaged from the weather! We also can't keep it cold for you in a cooler - even if it's your own cooler. This is why we want to make sure you'll be home to accept your box or that you are okay with our drop off. We are at our limit for monthly deliveries, but we are accepting applications from interested clients who would like this in 2023.
